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Dossia - What it is

Dossia is a multiple employer led initiative to enable life-long independent health records for consumers – www.Dossia.org

Large employers (Pitney Bowes, Intel, Wal-Mart, BP America, Applied Materials, Cardinal Health and two other large employers announcing soon) are funding independent not- for- profit to develop Dossia and deploy it to their workforces

Dossia is a secure infrastructure that will aggregate and store health care data at the request of individuals

Dossia will be run as a Public Utility

Individuals control access to data through a commercial PHR application

Data will be portable and can be accessed by consumers through any PHR application certified to access through an open API. API managed by independent body, possibly a standards organization.



Dossia - What it is not

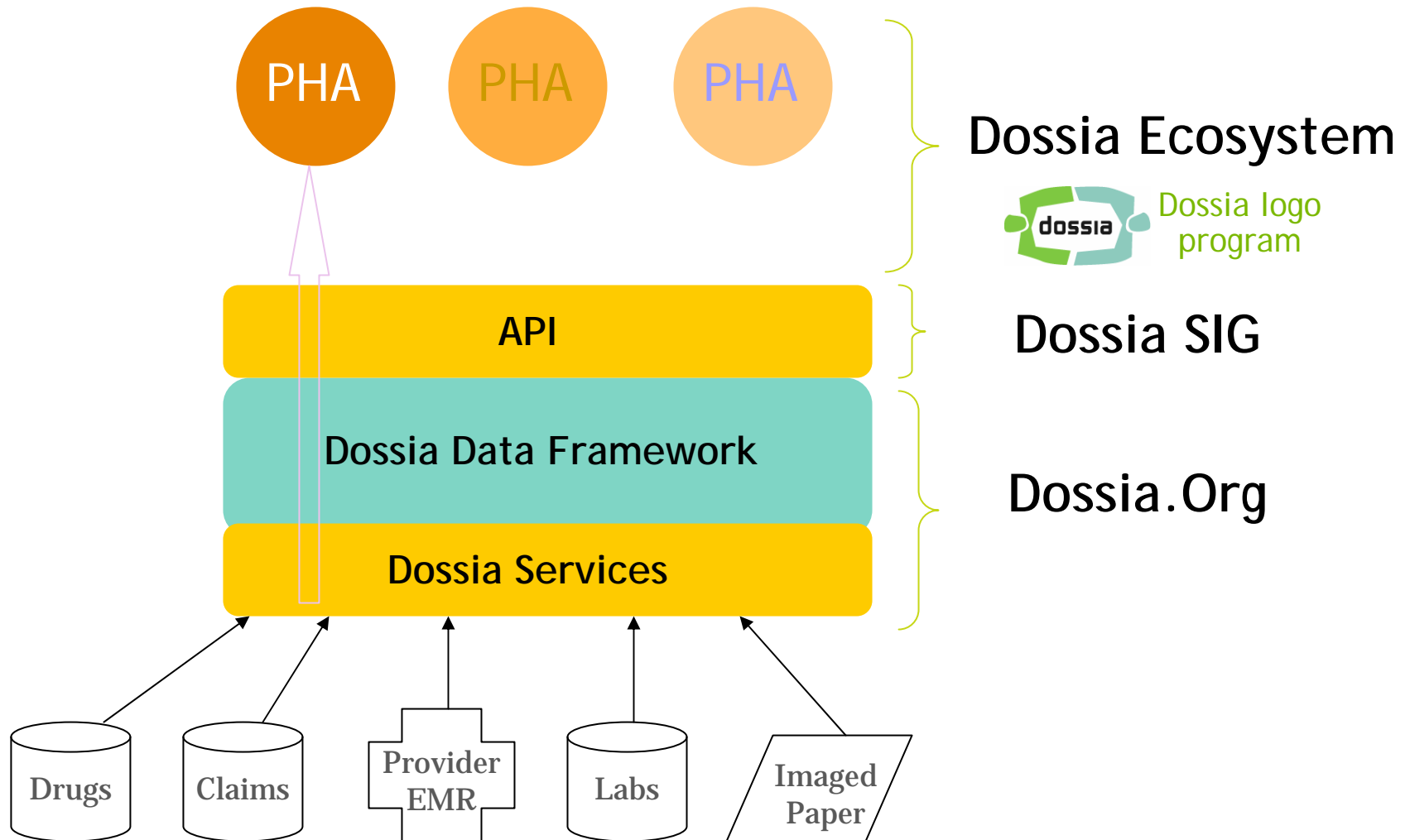
Not a PHR application; its open architecture will work with all consumer facing applications and will be made available to all PHR vendors including health plans. It will enable PHR development

Not a commercial activity for Founding Companies; goal is to accelerate adoption of IT in the health care industry

Not tethered to any of current players in the HC system; infrastructure can support all entities
